The program places Oral Health Practitioners in aged care facilities to conduct oral health risk asssessments, formulate oral health care plans and provide appropriate referrals for timely dental treatment to both the public and private sectors. The Oral Health Practitioner will also provide oral health instruction and education to residents, carers and staff.
